Aggie Health and Wellness Travel Services are by appointment only.

Travel consultations are available to all NMSU students, staff, faculty and townspersons. We recommend you book your travel consultation at least four weeks prior to your planned travel.

Travel consultations include

- A printed and or digital report specific to your travel destinations including country-specific considerations.
- Immunization record review and immunizations.
- Prescription for anti-malarial medication.

Travel Appointment and Information

Please call (575) 646-1512 for an appointment. A receptionist will collect basic information and you will be contacted by a nurse to schedule your travel appointment.

Travel Consultation Visit Fee

- NMSU students- \$0 for travel consultations, vaccine costs will be discussed prior to administration.
- NMSU Faculty/ Staff and Townspersons- \$55 for travel consultations, full cost of vaccines will be required prior to administration.

Immunization Costs

- Cost for vaccines varies and is not included in the consultation fee. For more information regarding specific vaccines, please contact a staff nurse at (575) 646-1512.
